

# Department of Psychiatry Case Conference

## **Purpose**

The primary purpose of this conference is to discuss clinical cases together as a department. The participants will generally include staff psychiatrists and psychologists, residents, psychology interns, consulting internists, pharmacology faculty and residents and medical students. Other participants are welcome. Graduate physician participants may receive one hour of Category 1 CME credit for participation, and other disciplines may claim CEU credit. The conference will also provide a quality management function for the medical staff.

## **Preparation**

The assigned presenter may choose a case from any work site as long as they have personally worked with that patient. The case would ideally be current, but may be a contact from the past. Presenters should prepare a **written (hard copy) summary of the case**, which will be handed out to participants (make 60 copies in advance). The summary should be no longer than three pages. Please have someone read through your summary for grammatical errors prior to making copies. **Please be extremely careful to avoid any possibility of identifying the patient in your summary.** Supplemental articles and other handouts are welcome but not required.

## **Presentation**

Please plan to make an **oral summary** of the case **lasting no longer than 10 minutes**. This is essential in order to leave sufficient time to discuss the case fully.

## **Participation**

All who attend are welcome to make comments and ask questions. **Please make every effort to be on time** out of respect for your colleague who has worked hard to prepare their case.
